Cash at Bank

The Official Receiver realised £5,588 prior to my appointment as liquidator from funds held in the company's bank account. During my appointment I collected a further £79 in this respect

Bank Interest Net of Tax

I have received £66 in respect of bank interest net of tax

Official Receiver's Credit Balance

I received £1,777 in respect of the Official Receiver's credit balance at the date of my appointment. This represents the amount realised by the Official Receiver in respect of cash at bank less their costs.

Director's Loans and Void Transactions

As previously reported, my investigations revealed the following amounts due from the director

- An adverse loan account of £37,627, and
- Payments of £16,559 made to him between the presentation of the winding up petition and the making of the order which are void pursuant to Section 127 of the Insolvency Act 1986

The director confirmed these amounts were due and owing and repaid a total of £50,000 in full and final settlement, which was accepted on a commercial basis due to the savings on costs

Furniture & Equipment

My investigations into the affairs of the company revealed the company had chattel assets with a book value of approximately £6,000. I instructed the director to deliver up all known assets to my agents for sale and I realised £213 in this respect. The company's fixed asset register detailed assets which were not delivered up by the director but, given the value, the costs of pursuing these assets and the sale of the same would outweigh any benefit to creditors and therefore no action was taken

LIABILITIES

Secured Liabilities

An examination of the company's mortgage register held by the Registrar of Companies, showed that the company has not granted any debentures

Preferential Creditors

The company's records anticipated no preferential creditors and no claims have been received

Crown Creditors

The company's records indicated £21,019 was owed to HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC") 1 have received and admitted HMRC's final claim of 17,654 in respect of Corporation Tax. HMRC received a first a final distribution of which I go into detail below

Unsecured Creditors

The Official Receiver's report included 1 unsecured creditor excluding HMRC with an estimated liability of £72,873. I received 1 claim totalling £78,147 of which was admitted

Unsecured creditors, including HMRC received a first and final distribution of 7 04 p in the £ on 10 July 2015. The amount distributed totalled £6,744 and all dividend cheques were banked

INVESTIGATION INTO THE AFFAIRS OF THE COMPANY

Within six months of the liquidation, the Official Receiver was required to submit a confidential report to the Secretary of State to include any matters which have come to their attention which may indicate that the conduct of any past or present director would make him unfit to be concerned with the management of the company I can confirm my report has been submitted

LIQUIDATOR'S REMUNERATION

My remuneration was previously authorised by creditors at a meeting held on 14 November 2013 to be drawn on a time cost basis. Total time costs to date amount to £29,322 and is inclusive of £15,268 incurred since my appointment on 22 May 2014 and £3,551 in the period 22 May 2015 to 13 May 2016. I have drawn £27,730 and my outstanding time costs will be written off.

A schedule of my time costs incurred to date is attached to this report. A description of the routine work undertaken in the liquidation to date is as follows

- Maintaining creditor information
- Reviewing and adjudicating on proofs of debt received from creditors

4 Investigations

- Review and storage of books and records
- Prepare a return pursuant to the Company Directors Disqualification Act
- Conduct investigations into suspicious transactions
- Review books and records to identify any transactions or actions a liquidator may take against a third party in order to recover funds for the benefit of creditors

5 Realisation of Assets

Any secured creditor may make a similar application to court within the same time limit.
