NEXPRESS LIMITED (IN ADMINISTRATION) ("THE COMPANY") IN THE LEICESTER COUNTY COURT NO 6AO OF 05

Further to my appointment as joint administrator of the above company on 22 December 2005 and my progress report dated 21 July 2006, I report on the progress of the administration under Rule 2.47 of the Insolvency Rules 1986. Statutory information regarding the company and the appointment of the administrators is given at Appendix A.

1. The Administrators' Proposals

The Administrators proposals' in accordance with Paragraph 49 of Schedule B1 to the Insolvency Act 1986 included the realisation of the Company's assets for the benefit of the secured or preferential creditors, which is continuing.

The administration order is being extended for a further six months to 22 June 2007 in order to realise additional assets for the benefit of the creditors as detailed below.

2. Progress of the Administration

I attach at Appendix B an abstract of my receipts and payments for the period from 23 June 2006 to 30 November 2006 together with a receipts and payments account for the full period of the administration to 30 November 2006 This shows realisations of £69,302 85.

Following our appointment it was ascertained that possible preference payments had been made to certain directors and officers of the Company. In addition an invalid distraint had been exercised by the landlord prior to Administration. Accordingly we have been progressing these potential recoveries which have a possible gross value in the region of £100,000. However as these claims are being denied by all the relevant parties we have had to instruct lawyers and it is possible that legal proceedings will be commenced shortly. However unless an extension to the Administration Order is granted by the secured and preferential creditors these claims will fall away. Therefore it is our opinion that it is in the creditors' interests that these claims are pursued and accordingly would request that you agree to the extension of the Administration Order for a further six months.

3. Estimated outcome

There is no prospect at this time of funds being available for unsecured creditors. If the claims referred to above are successful, there could be a dividend to preferential creditors of the Company.



4. Administrators' Remuneration

As, to date in this case, neither preferential nor unsecured creditors have been expected to receive a dividend we have obtained approval from the floating charge holders as to the basis of the Administrators' fees and remuneration. This has been drawn as can be seen in the Receipts and payment account in Appendix B. An analysis of the time charged, showing different grades of staff and the type of work undertaken, is attached at Appendix C however at this time no further request for the drawing remuneration has been made.
