1 Accounting Policies

Basis of measurement and preparation of accounts

The Director of the Company believes that the Company's former bankers, NatWest Ltd., repossessed the stocks and work-in-progress of the Company fraudulently. This left the Company with no assets or cashflow, resulting in the cessation of trade. The Company is currently seeking restitution from NatWest Ltd through the Courts. Until the outcome of the case is known it is prudent that the Director reflects £nil balances in the accounts, other than the shareholding.
