REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES (continued) FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 JULY 2012

The work of the Youth Space Group, the Housing and Built Environment Forum and the Traffic and Transport Forum has continued throughout the year. The Housing and Built Environment Forum and the Traffic and Transport Forum have now both became recognised advisory Groups to Totnes Town Council.

The Housing Forum has continued to works extensively to coordinate community responses to various development sites arising from the Planning Authority's Local Development Framework Plans. They are working closely with the Town Council to develop a plan for producing a Neighbourhood Plan, having been instrumental in securing "front runner" status.

The Traffic and Transport Forum has been similarly coordinating community responses to Traffic issues and has taken a lead role in working with Devon County Council on a potentially £1m project entitled Totnes on the Move which is promoting sustainable traffic initiatives in the town and surrounding area

During the year, Trustees of the Strategy Group concluded that, with the groups now operating independently, they had achieved all they could and the company should be wound up. Each group has been encouraged to join an alternative accountable body, and the remaining unallocated funds were used to provide a grant to the Totnes Festival, and to the two Forums. Trustees have ensured that the funds will be properly ring fenced and used for the purposes that they were provided by each of the new accountable bodies, all of whom are recognised charities.
