Notes to the Abbreviated Accounts for the period ended 31 March 2016

1 Accounting Policies

Basis of measurement and preparation of accounts

The full financial statements, from which these abbreviated accounts have been extracted, have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2015).

Turnover policy

Turnover represents income from services provided during the period, excluding value added tax. Advances payable on signature of a contract that are repayable are deferred, net of costs, until the conditions for repayment no longer apply. For most contracts the conditions for repayment include delivery, acceptance or publication.

Tangible assets depreciation policy

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases:

Plant and machinery - Straight line over 4 years

Fixtures and fittings - Straight line over 4 years

Computer equipment - Straight line over 4 years
