NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS

FOR THE YEAR ENDED 29th FEBRUARY 2008

1. Accounting policies

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2007).

The company has taken advantage of the exemption from preparing a cash-flow statement as conferred by Financial Reporting Standard No. 1 (Revised 1996) on the grounds that it qualifies as a small company under the Companies Act 1985.

Going concern

The accounts have been prepared on a going concern basis, which the director considers to be appropriate.

Leasing and hire purchase commitments

Assets obtained under hire purchase contracts and finance leases are capitalised as tangible assets and depreciated as below. Obligations under such agreements are included as creditors net of the finance charge allocated to future periods. The finance element of the rental payment is charged to the profit and loss account so as to produce a constant periodic rate of charge on the net obligation outstanding in each period.

Lease payments under operating leases, where substantially all the risks and benefits remain with the lessor, are charged as expenses in the periods in which they are incurred.

Deferred taxation

Deferred tax arises as a result of including items of income and expenditure in tax computations in periods different from those in which they are included in the company's accounts. Deferred tax is provided in full on timing differences which result in an obligation to pay more (or less) tax at a future date, at the average tax rates that are expected to apply when the timing differences reverse, based on current tax rates and laws.

Deferred tax is not provided on timing differences arising from the revaluation of a fixed asset where there is no commitment to sell the asset.

1. Accounting policies (continued)

Goodwill

Purchased Goodwill is the difference between the purchase price of a business and its net asset value. Purchased Goodwill is capitalised and depreciated on a straight line basis over its useful economic life.

The Purchased Goodwill owned by the company during the year was depreciated over 3 years, which the director considers to be reasonable.

Depreciation

Depreciation of fixed assets is calculated to write off their cost or valuation less any residual value over their estimated useful lives, as follows:-

Commercial vehicles
Office equipment, furniture & fittings

25% reducing balance 15-25% reducing balance

Computer equipment 33% on cost

Foreign currency translation

Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rates of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date. Transactions in foreign currencies are recorded at the rate of exchange ruling at the date of the transaction. All differences are taken to the profit and loss account.

Turnover

Turnover, which excludes value added tax, represents the invoiced value of goods and services supplied. During the year, none of the company's turnover was to markets outside the United Kingdom.

5. Control

In the opinion of the director, the company was controlled by the director, Jonathan Aylmer, by virtue of his holding of 100% of the company's share capital.

6. Related party transactions

During the year, management recharges were made between the company, Oxfordshire Garden Furniture Ltd and Oceans International Ltd, all companies under common control, where administrative costs were incurred by one of these companies on behalf of another. The amount of these recharges was £3,230 charged by the company to Oxfordshire Garden Furniture Ltd (2007: £67,993) and £7,136 charged by the company to Oceans International Ltd (2007: £13,542).

During the year, the company purchased goods totalling £nil (2007:£105,036) from Oceans International Ltd.

These related companies also, from time to time, paid liabilities on behalf of the company and vice-versa.

All of the above transactions were charged on an arms-length basis.

At 29th February 2008, the amount owed to the company by Oxfordshire Garden Furniture Ltd was £16,724 (2007: £131,658), and the amount owed to the company by Oceans International Ltd was £nil (2007: £nil).

During the year, various advances were made to the company by the director and various amounts were drawn against this loan. The balance on this loan account is non-interest bearing and has no fixed repayment date. At 29th February 2008, the amount owed by the company to the director was £nil (2007: £40,138).
