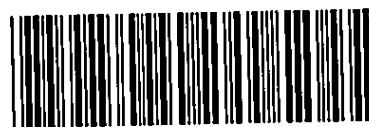




**Statement by the directors**
