## 1 Accounting policies

## Basis of preparation

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective

## Exemption from preparing a cash flow statement

Exemption has been taken from preparing a cash flow statement on the grounds that the company qualifies as a small company

#### Turnover

Turnover shown in the profit and loss account represents amounts earned during the year exclusive of Value Added Tax

#### Tangible fixed assets and depreciation

Tangible fixed assets are stated at cost less depreciation. Depreciation is provided at rates calculated to write off the cost of fixed assets, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases.

Computer and equipment-33 33% per annum straight line basis

## Intangible fixed assets and amortisation

Expenditure on development is written off in the year it is incurred, except that development expenditure incurred on an individual project is carried forward when its future recoverability can reasonably be regarded as assured. The expenditure carried forward is treated as an intangible asset and amortised over its estimated economic life of five years so as to match he expenditure with the anticipated sales from the related project. Amortisation is provided at a rate calculated to write off the cost of development costs, less their estimated residual value, over their expected useful lives on the following bases.

Development cost-20% per annum straight line basis

Trademark is stated at cost less amortisation. Amortisation is provided over the period of registration on the following bases

Trademark-10% per annum straight line basis

## Deferred taxation

The charge for taxation takes into account taxation deferred as a result of timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes. In general, deferred taxation is recognised in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed at the balance sheet date. However, deferred tax assets are recognised only to the extent that the directors consider that it is more likely than not that they will be recovered against the reversal of deferred tax liabilities or other future taxable profits. Deferred taxation is measured on a non-discounted basis at the average tax rates that would apply when the timing differences are expected to reverse, based on tax rates and laws that have been enacted by the balance sheet date.

## Foreign currencies

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Monetary assets and liabilities in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rates of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date. Transactions in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rate ruling on the date of the transaction. Exchange differences are taken into account in arriving at the operating profit.

Expenditure on hosting costs is written off in the year it is incurred
