ORDER

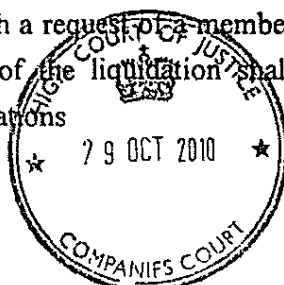
UPON THE APPLICATION of Samantha Jane Keen, (the "Applicant") by Originating  
Application dated 7 October 2010

AND UPON READING the First Witness Statement of Samantha Jane Keen

IT IS ORDERED THAT

1. In relation to each Members' Voluntary Liquidation identified in Schedule 1 attached  
to this application
  - (a) the Applicant be removed from the office of Liquidator of the relevant  
company, and

- (b) the First Respondent be appointed as Liquidator thereof
- 2 In relation to each of the Members' Voluntary Liquidations identified in Schedules 2 to 8 attached to this application
- (a) the Applicant be removed from the office of Joint Liquidator of the relevant company or Limited Liability Partnership (the "LLP"), and
- (b) the First Respondent be appointed as Joint Liquidator thereof.
- 3 The Applicant shall procure that, at the first convenient opportunity to do so and in any event within three months of the date of this Order, a block advertisement in relation to each of the estates is placed in the London Gazette containing notification of the following matters
- (a) the removal of the Applicant from the office of Joint Liquidator or Liquidator of the estates identified in Schedules 1 to 8 attached to this Application (together the "**Schedules**") and the appointment of the First Respondent as Liquidator or Joint Liquidator,
- (b) the fact that any creditor or member of the estates may apply, within 28 days after the notice has been advertised, to vary or discharge this Order,
- (c) that any individual creditor or member of the relevant company or the LLP can apply within 28 days after the notice has been advertised for an order that an account be given of the Applicant's administration of the liquidation,
- (d) that the costs of complying with a request of a creditor or member for an account of the Applicant's administration of the liquidation should be an expense of the relevant Members' Voluntary Liquidations, and
- (e) the fact that the Applicant will be entitled to apply to the Secretary of State for her release 42 days after the notice has been advertised
- 4 Any creditor or member of the relevant company or the LLP may apply, within 28 days after the notice has been advertised, to vary or discharge this Order
- 5 Any individual member or creditor of the relevant company or the LLP may apply within 28 days after the notice has been advertised for an order that an account be given of the Applicant's administration of the liquidation
- 6 The costs of complying with a request of a member or creditor for an account of the Applicant's administration of the liquidation shall be an expense of the relevant Members' Voluntary Liquidations



- 7 The Applicant may apply to the Secretary of State for her release 42 days after the notice referred to in paragraph 3 above has been advertised
- 8 In relation to the Members' Voluntary Liquidations listed in the Schedules hereto, and insofar as the Insolvency Act 1986 or the Insolvency Rules 1986 contains any requirement for any appointment of an office-holder to be advertised, the requirement be dispensed with save to the extent provided for in paragraph 3 above
- 9 Insofar as the Applicant is required by law to give any notice of the appointment, the relevant Respondent appointed in her place be entitled to sign and send any such notice on her behalf in such manner as the court may direct
- 10 No order as to costs
