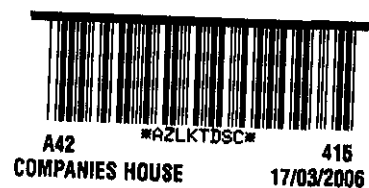

The trustees present their first report and the financial statements of the company for the period ended 30 November 2004. The company was incorporated on 22 March 2004 and, consequently, these financial statements cover the period between that date and 30 November 2004.

Status

The company is limited by guarantee, not having a share capital. It is registered with the Charity Commission as a registered charity. With effect from 1 December 2004, it undertook the activities previously carried on by the unincorporated body known as "Muslim Hands".

Objectives

The principal objective of the company is the relief of poverty and sickness anywhere in the world, and in particular amongst those affected by natural disaster or by war and other conflict by the provision of financial and educational assistance, including medicines, hospitals, shelter and food.

Results

The company did not carry out any activities during the period under review.


Trustees

1 Accounting policies

Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with applicable accounting standards.

The company is limited by guarantee, and has no issued share capital. In the event of the company being wound up each member undertakes to contribute to the assets of the company such sum as may be required not exceeding £1.
