1 Accounting policies

1 1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention

12 Turnover

Turnover represents amounts received for membership fees and services net of VAT and trade discounts

13 Deferred taxation

Deferred tax is provided in full in respect of taxation deferred by timing differences between the treatment of certain items for taxation and accounting purposes. The deferred tax balance has not been discounted

14 Foreign currency translation

Monetary assets and liabilities denominated in foreign currencies are translated into sterling at the rates of exchange ruling at the balance sheet date.
