IT IS ORDERED that

- (1) the name of the above named Powerfuel PLC be restored to the Register of Companies
- (2) if at the date of registration of this Order with the Registrar of Companies the name of the Company is not available the Registrar of Companies shall pursuant to Section 1033(2)(a)(ii) and (b) of the Companies Act 2006 change the name of the Company to 05113279 PLC
- (3) an Office Copy of this Order be delivered to the Registrar of Companies and pursuant to the above mentioned Act the company is thereupon to be deemed to have continued in existence as if its name had not been struck off
- (4) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"
