LYNX MODEL WORKS LIMITED - IN LIQUIDATION

This is the Joint Liquidators second annual report upon this matter. This report should be read in conjunction with the report of the initial meeting of creditors and subsequent annual report.

1. RECEIPTS AND PAYMENTS ACCOUNT

We attach an account of receipts and payments for the current period 20 February 2016 to 19 February 2017 and cumulatively from the commencement of the winding up to the end of the anniversary

2. REALISATIONS

Assets

The assets of the Company, being plant & machinery and computer equipment, were seized and sold at auction by HM Revenue & Customs prior to the approval of a Company Voluntary Arrangement in August 2013.

As previously reported, an agreement was made between the Joint Liquidators and the director, Mr John Clarke, to sell the goodwill of the Company for the sum of £4,800.00, to Lynx Model Paint & Machining Services Limited

As creditors are aware, on 3 August 2015 a Statutory Demand was issued to the director due to his failure to make payments and his lack of cooperation, to which he made contact with the Joint Liquidators and agreed to make monthly payments of £500 00 in respect of the goodwill. However, the total sum of £1,850 00 has been received to date in respect of this and no further payments have been received since the issuing of the first annual report, despite the constant requests for payment from the Joint Liquidators.

In view of the above, the Joint Liquidators have considered all options available to them and are currently in the process of taking suitable steps to attempt to recover the funds due into the liquidation, and to enforce the director's cooperation. A further update will be provided to creditors in due course

3. JOINT LIQUIDATORS' REMUNERATION

A Statement of Affairs fee of £5,000.00 was approved at the initial meeting of creditors held on 20 February 2015, of which the sum of £1,436.67 plus VAT has been drawn on account

The Joint Liquidators' remuneration is based on hourly costs at scale rates calculated on the time properly spent in the course of the liquidation and was approved at the initial meeting of creditors held on 20 February 2015.



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In the current period the Joint Liquidators' have incurred time costs of £6,181 00 representing 31.64 hours at an average hourly charge-out rate of £195 35. Total time spent to date on this assignment amounts to 96 34 hours at an average composite rate of £180 06 per hour resulting in total time costs to date of £17,347 25. There are insufficient funds to draw Joint Liquidators' fees, therefore, none have been drawn to date leaving outstanding time costs of £17,347 25

Disbursements of £476 66 have been allocated to the case up to the anniversary of which £107.00 has been drawn leaving unbilled disbursements of £369.66

The following further information as regards time costs is enclosed

- Silke and Co policy for re-charging expenses
- Silke and Co charge-out rates

All other payments have been made in accordance with the rules and regulations generally as to the payment of costs and expenses in the liquidation

A Creditors' Guide to Liquidators' Fees is also enclosed, which includes creditors' rights to further information and to challenge

4. CREDITORS' CLAIMS AND DIVIDEND PROSPECTS

Ordinary unsecured claims have been received amounting to £182,033.38, the director's statement of affairs estimated unsecured claims of £245,264.74.

At this stage although creditors' claims have been lodged we have not taken steps to formally agree the claims of unsecured creditors as it appears unlikely there will be a dividend payable to unsecured creditors until and unless further assets are realised

5. OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

Investigation

We have carried out our statutory duties in respect of reporting on the conduct of the Company's director

Further to the previous annual report, the Joint Liquidators instructed The Wilkes Partnership Solicitors to assist with the recovery of the Company books and records, and requested copies of the bank statements for the account held in the name of Mrs Rosemary Clarke, which was used for the trading of the business. As a result of this, minimal records were provided to the Joint Liquidators which related to a period which was not beneficial to the Joint Liquidators.

Due to the lack of cooperation from the director, the Joint Liquidators are now taking suitable steps to attempt to enforce cooperation from the director, and to retrieve the funds due into the liquidation, as detailed in Section 3 of this report

6. CONCLUSION

As detailed above, due to the outstanding payments and the ongoing investigations, it is not possible to confirm the timescale for conclusion of the liquidation at present.



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We will report again following the third anniversary of the liquidation or at the conclusion of the winding up, whichever is the sooner.

Disbursements

Definitions

Category 1 - approval not required - specific expenditure that is directly related to a particular insolvency case, where the cost of the expense incurred is referable against an independent external supplier's invoice or published tariff of charges.

Category 2 - approval required - all other items of expenditure. Which cannot, or cannot easily, be directly related to a particular insolvency case because there is an element of shared or allocated cost, and/or where the cost of the expense incurred is an estimated, utilised cost with the estimate based on external costs or opportunity costs.

Charging Policy of Silke & Co Limited

Category 1 expenses are recharged to the particular insolvency case at the rate incurred by Silke & Co Limited and as they are incurred.

Category 2 expenses, the following items are recharged at the following rates.

- Where meeting rooms of Silke & Co Limited are used for the purpose of statutory meetings of creditors the room hire is recharged to the individual insolvency case at £150 per meeting.
- Car mileage is recharged to the individual insolvency case at the rate of 45p per mile.
- The storage of books and records (when not charged as a Category 1 expense) is recharged at the rate of £1.50 per box per month.
- Printing and photocopying is charged at 15p per sheet.
- Faxes are charged at 50p per sheet.
- Postage is charged at the relevant prevailing rate
- IPS computer charge £6.25 per Month (maximum £200 per case).
- Stationery charged at £5.00 per file
