We have provided employment for a single mother dealing in laptop parts from broken laptops over the course of the year which has allowed her to improve her standard of living as part of the government working families scheme and in the longer term with the experience gained has enabled her to become self-employed in a greater capacity in general. As a non-profit making organisation any revenue generated is put back into the organisation to allow it to continue its community activities and provide a valuable local service for the benefit of the individual, small business client base and disadvanatged groups such as prisoners and single parents.
