2. Progress to Date

- 2.1 The receipts and payments account attached in Appendix I details the asset realisations to date
- The Cash at Bank estimated at £762 was realised in the sum of £697 54, being the closing balance

The estimated statement of affairs showed Supplier Overpayments of £145, however these have not been recoverable

Book Debts and Retentions estimated at £20,000, has proven to be unrealistic due to the majority of monies having been remitted to the company some months prior to Liquidation. My Agent has submitted a report and showing that there is only a possible sum of £1,500 to be realised, which is awaiting the expiration of a Defect Liability Period on work undertaken.

3. Investigations

An appropriate report/return on the actions of the directors has been forwarded to the Disqualification Unit of the Department for Business Innovation & Skills in accordance with the liquidator's statutory duties. Please note that the content of this report/return are of a privileged and confidential nature and so cannot be disclosed to third parties.

4 Liquidator's Remuneration and Category 2 Disbursements

4.1 At the initial meeting of creditors held on 28 March 2012 the following resolutions were passed.

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- That the remuneration of the liquidator be fixed by reference to the time properly given by the liquidator and his staff in attending to matters arising in the liquidation in accordance with Rule 4 127(2)(b) of the Insolvency Rules 1986
- The liquidator shall be authorised to draw his firm's internal costs and expenses in dealing
 with the estate, including photocopying, printing, facsimile, storage, mileage and room hire,
 as and when funds permit
- The time costs incurred to date have arisen primarily as a result of dealing with the statutory functions required under the Insolvency Act and Rules and also enquiries from creditors
- A detailed breakdown of liquidator's time costs and category 2 disbursements, together with current charge out rates is attached in Appendix II. To date, no fees have been drawn

- The costs of convening the original meeting of creditors pursuant to Rule 4 62 of the Insolvency Rules 1986 of £3,500 was paid to Moore Stephens LLP from company assets prior to liquidation
- The costs of preparing the company's statement of affairs pursuant to Rule 4 38 of the Insolvency Rules 1986 of £1,500 was paid to Aggarwal & Co from company assets prior to liquidation

5 Liquidator's Expenses

A schedule of all expenses incurred in the period have been detailed in Appendix III. To date all expenses have been borne by my firm. The costs of my Quantity Surveyor, Roger Metcalfe Associates will be paid from any recoveries of contract balances.

6. Creditors' Rights

Within 21 days of receipt of this report, a secured creditor, or an unsecured creditor (with the concurrence of at least 5% in value of the unsecured creditors) or any unsecured creditor with the permission of the court may request in writing that the liquidator provide further information about his remuneration or expenses which have been itemised in the Progress Report

Within 14 days of receipt of the request, I must provide all of the information asked for, except so far as I consider that.

- the time or cost of preparation of the information would be excessive, or
- disclosure of the information would be prejudicial to the conduct of the liquidation or might reasonably be expected to lead to violence against any person, or
- I am subject to an obligation of confidentiality in respect of the information.

I am also is required to give reasons for not providing all of the requested information

6.2. Any secured creditor, or an unsecured creditor (with the concurrence of at least 10% in value of the unsecured creditors) may, within eight weeks of receipt of this Progress Report make an application to court on the grounds that the basis fixed for the liquidator's remuneration, the remuneration charged, or the expenses incurred by the liquidator as set out in the Progress Report are excessive

7 1. Secured Creditors

There are no secured creditors

7.2. Preferential Creditors

I am not aware of any preferential creditors other than the Redundancy Payments Office for employees' arrears of pay and holiday pay. However, to date I have received no claim from them but in any event it is unlikely that a dividend will become payable to this class of creditor.

7 3. Non-Preferential Creditors

The estimated statement of affairs indicated that non-preferential debts were £119,257. I have received a number of claims and will not adjudicate upon the same due to tack of funds and dividend prospect.
