1 ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable accounting standards. The particular accounting policies adopted are described below

(a) Accounting Convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention

(b) <u>Tangible Fixed Assets</u>

Depreciation is provided on a straight line basis over the expected useful lives of each category of tangible fixed assets

Computer Equipment

33 % per annum on cost

(c) <u>Deferred Taxation</u>

Deferred taxation is recognised in respect of all timing differences, between the treatment of certain items for accounts purposes and their treatment for tax purposes, that have originated but not reversed by the balance sheet date

Deferred taxation is not recognised when assets are revalued unless, by the balance sheet date, the company has entered into a binding agreement to sell the assets and recognised the gains and losses expected to arise on sale or where assets have been sold and it is expected that the taxable gain will be rolled over into a replacement asset

(d) Pension Costs

The company has a defined contribution pension scheme The cost of the contributions made by the company to the scheme are charged to the profit and loss account as incurred

(e) Cash Flow Statement

The company qualifies as a small company under the Companies Act 2006. The directors have elected to take advantage of the exemptions under FRS 1 not to prepare a cash flow statement
