#### Structure, governance and management

The charity is a company limited by guarantee and was formed on 17 January 2005. It is governed by a memorandum and articles of association. The liability of the members in the event of the company being wound up is limited to a sum not exceeding £1.

#### Method of recruitment and appointment of trustees

The trustees of the charity are also the directors for the purposes of company law and are appointed by the members at the AGM

#### Trustees' report (continued) for the year ended 31 August 2011

#### Objectives and activities

#### The charity's objects

To advance the development and education of children under statutory school age in Todmorden ('the area of benefit') by providing a comprehensive childcare service offering facilities for recreation and safe and satisfying play and to provide or to arrange for the provision of such ancillary facilities and activities as are considered necessary or desirable for the fulfilment of the objects

#### The charity's main activities

To provide childcare for children aged 0-5 years and before and after school activities for 3-11 year olds

#### **Public benefit statement**

In setting our objectives and planning our activities our trustees have given serious consideration to the Charity Commission's general guidance on public benefit and in particular the advancement of education

#### Achievements and performance

ABC was inspected by Ofsted in the Spring of 2011 and was judged to be "good" - we were very pleased with the outcome

In addition the nursery has achieved the Local Authority Quality Mark.

We are committed to continuous staff training and currently exceed the government guidelines for qualified staff

There is a high retention of staff at ABC which reflects the high quality provision

We have undertaken a number of fundraising activities during the year which included a 12 mile sponsored walk by the staff and a curry evening for parents of the children. The staff made all the curries.

#### Financial review

The net expenditure for the year was £25,064 including net expenditure of £22,544 on unrestricted funds and net expenditure of £2,520 on restricted funds

#### Reserves policy

The charity's free reserves, excluding fixed assets, at the year end were £37,235

Once a year the directors of ABC Nursery will consider the level of reserves that it is prudent for the organisation to hold. Consideration will be given to redundancy liabilities, lease agreements and any other significant factors that should be taken into account if the nursery was to close. The directors have approved a policy to build unrestricted reserves to cover these eventualities, and additional sufficient resources to cover core running costs for a period of three months. Monies equivalent to the policy will be held in a separate reserve account.

Statement of trustees' responsibilities

The trustees (who are also the directors for the purposes of company law) are responsible for preparing the Trustees report and the financial statements in accordance with the applicable law and UK Accounting Standards

I report on the accounts of the charitable company for the year ended 31 August 2011, which are set out on pages 6 to 10

#### Respective responsibilities of the trustees and the examiner

The trustees (who are also the directors of the company for the purposes of company law) are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. #### 1 Accounting policies

#### Basis of accounting

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention. The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the Statement of Recommended Practice. Accounting and Reporting by Charities (SORP 2005), the Companies Act 2006 and Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

There has been no change to the accounting policies since last year No changes have been made to the accounts for previous years

#### Incoming resources

All incoming resources are included in the Statement of Financial Activities (SOFA) when the charity becomes entitled to the resources, the trustees are virtually certain they will receive the resources and the monetary value can be measured with sufficient reliability

#### **Grants and donations**

Grants and donations are only included in the SOFA when the charity has unconditional entitlement to the resources

Where grants are related to performance and specific deliverables, they are accounted for as the charity earns the right to consideration by its performance

#### **Expenditure** and liabilities

Expenditure is recognised on an accrual basis as a liability is incurred. Liabilities are recognised as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to pay out the resources

#### **Taxation**

As a charity the organisation benefits from rates relief and is generally exempt from income tax and capital gains tax but not from VAT. Irrecoverable VAT is included in the cost of those items to which it relates

#### Tangible fixed assets

Tangible fixed assets costing more than £300 are capitalised and included at cost including any incidental expenses of acquisition. Gifted assets are shown at the value to the charity on receipt. Depreciation is provided on all tangible fixed assets at rates calculated to write off the cost on a straight line basis over their expected useful economic lives as follows.

Fixtures and fittings 15% to nil

Equipment over 5 years

#### Fund accounting

Unrestricted funds are available for use at the discretion of the trustees in furtherance of the general objectives of the charity

Restricted funds are subjected to restrictions on their expenditure imposed by the donor or through the terms of an appeal

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the accounts
