In accordance with the provisions of Section 94 of the Insolvency Act 1986, I present, for your information, my final progress report on the liquidation for the period to 7 August 2015 to 2 March 2016.

# Statutory Information

I, Malcolm Cohen, of BDO LLP, 55 Baker Street, London, W1U 7EU was appointed as Liquidator of the Company on 7 August 2015

The Company was incorporated on 7 February 2005 and its registered number is listed above. The Company was formerly known as Alnery No 2490 Limited until 17 February 2005, then as Nikko Energy Resources Limited until 9 May 2005 when it changed to its present name. It does not have any other trading style.

The Company's former registered office was Citigroup Centre, Canada Square, Canary Wharf, London, E14 5LB The registered office was changed to 55 Baker Street, London, W1U 7EU following my appointment

### General Overview

As detailed in my report below, all matters in the liquidation have now been settled. I have obtained tax clearances from HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC") and therefore I am now in a position to conclude the case. Dissolution of the Company will follow approximately three months after the date that the final meeting is held.

### Receipts & Payments

There have been no receipts or payments through the liquidation estate. The Declaration of Solvency sworn by the Company's directors showed that the Company had no assets and no liabilities.

### HM Revenue & Customs ("HMRC")

The Company's tax agent submitted corporation tax returns for all outstanding pre-liquidation periods following my appointment

The Company was part of a VAT group and was removed from the group with effect from the date of my appointment

I consequently sought formal tax clearances from the Corporation Tax office and from the Enforcement and Insolvency Service ("EIS") at HMRC for the pre and post liquidation periods, together with confirmation that no further returns are required and that there are no objections to the liquidation being closed

I have now received all confirmations from HMRC that there is no claim outstanding and no objections to the liquidation being closed

#### Distributions

As detailed above, the Company has no assets and hence no distribution will be made

### Liquidator's Remuneration

Pursuant to the Insolvency Rules 1986, the Liquidator is obliged to fix his remuneration in accordance with Rule 4 148A(2) of the Insolvency Rules 1986. This permits remuneration to be fixed either:

- (1) as a percentage of the assets realised and distributed, and/or
- (2) by reference to the time the Liquidator and the staff have spent attending to matters in the liquidation, and/or
- (3) as a set amount, and/or
- (4) as a combination of the above

My remuneration was approved on a time cost basis by resolutions passed by the members on the date of my appointment. To date costs of £4,664 45 have been incurred by myself and my staff representing 12 7 hours at an average hourly rate of £367 28.

My staff and I have spent time on matters arising in the normal course of the liquidations. The main areas dealt with include

- liaising with the Company in relation to matters prior to the Liquidator's appointment,
- statutory reporting requirements to members,
- statutory reporting requirements to the Registrar of Companies,
- dealing with statutory advertising requirements,
- correspondence with HMRC in order to obtain the necessary clearances to close the liquidation, and
- convening of the final meeting of members

# Disbursements

Where disbursements are recovered in respect of precise sums expended to third parties there is no necessity for these costs to be authorised. These are known as category 1 disbursements

The sum of £612 06 has been incurred to date in respect of category 1 disbursements for statutory advertising costs and the cost of the indemnity bonding



The costs of the liquidation including the disbursements will be paid by an appropriate associated company as the Company does not hold any funds. I have raised an invoice for £4,500 plus VAT and disbursements in this matter. No further costs will be billed.

## Liquidation Closure

A report on the progress of the liquidation was presented and the shareholder duly resolved

- That the Liquidator is authorised to dispose of the Company's books and records one year after the dissolution of the Company
