#### 1 Basis of accounting

These accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention with items recognised at cost or transaction value unless otherwise stated in the relevant note(s) to these accounts.

On 1st April 2017, the net assets and activities of Home-Start Hounslow were transferred to Home-Start Richmond, which then became known as Home-Start Richmond, Kingston & Hounslow. These accounts aggregate the results of both charities and the comparative amounts for the prior period have also been aggregated to reflect the combined charities (Note 11).

The principal aim of the combined charity remains the promotion of the welfare of families with at least one child under five years of age. The geographical reach of families supported now extends across the boroughs of Richmond-upon-Thames, Kingston and Hounslow.
