1. Accounting policies

These financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the provisions of Section 1A (Small Entities) of Financial Reporting Standard 102

Turnover policy

Turnover is measured at the fair value of the consideration received or receivable. Turnover is reduced for estimated customer returns, rebates and similar allowances

Tangible fixed assets and depreciation policy

Tangible fixed assets held for the company's own use are stated at cost less accumulated depreciation and accumulated impairment losses. At each balance sheet date, the company reviews the carrying amount of its tangible fixed assets to determine whether there is any indication that any items have suffered an impairment loss. Depreciation is provided at the following annual rates in order to write off the cost of valuation less the estimated residual value of each asset over its estimated useful life. Leasehold land and buildings 25% reducing balance, plant and machinery 25% reducing balance, and motor vehicles 25% reducing balance.
