1 Accounting Policies

Basis of measurement and preparation of accounts

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standards for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

At the balance sheet date, the company had a shareholders' deficiency of £5,628 (2012: £5,318). At that date the company relied on the financial support of its parent undertaking to enable trading to continue. This support will continue for the foreseeable future and accordingly the financial statements have been prepared on the going concern basis.

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with the applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated).
