

1 Introduction and Statutory Information

- Lucinda Coleman and I, of Francis Clark LLP, Centenary House, Peninsula Park, Rydon Lane, Exeter, EX2 7XE, were appointed Liquidators of Hailey Properties Limited ("the Company") on 29 March 2022. We can be contacted by phone on 01392 667000 or via email at business.recovery@pkf-francisclark.co.uk.
- 1.2 This report provides an update on the progress in the liquidation for year ended 30 March 2024 ("the Period") and should be read in conjunction with previous progress.
- 1.3 Information about the way that we will use, and store personal data on insolvency appointments can be found at https://www.pkf-francisclark.co.uk/services/creditor/. If you are unable to download this, please contact us and a hard copy will be provided to you.
- 1.4 The trading address of the Company was Dunwantin, 40 Old Pound Close, Lytchett Matravers, Poole, BH16 6BW.
- 1.5 The registered office of the Company was changed to Centenary House, Peninsula Park, Rydon Lane, Exeter, EX2 7XE and its registered number is 05485346.

2 Progress of the Liquidation

- 2.1 At Appendix A is my Receipts and Payments account for the Period, with a comparison to the Declaration of Solvency values, together with cumulative figures since my appointment.
- 2.2 The Declaration of Solvency showed a debtor balance of £1,643.84, in respect apportioned rent accrued on a property prior to its sale. £1,424.98 has been collected during the Period and no further sums are due.
- 2.3 At the date of my appointment a VAT refund of £1,347 was due to the Company. This still hasn't been received but payment is expected soon.

Matters still to be dealt with

- 2.4 As above, I am still awaiting a VAT refund from HM Revenue and Customs.
- 2.5 Prior to December 2023 it was necessary for liquidators to obtain clearance from HM Revenue and Customs before a case could be closed. This is no longer possible but liquidators must still ensure that there are no further liabilities which need to be paid before closure. I will therefore need to issue a notice of intended distribution as part of the closure process.

2.6 Distributions to Members

- 2.7 The following cash distribution to members has been made since the date of my appointment:
 - An interim distribution of £71,250 per share on 4 April 2022
- 2.8 In addition the following distribution in specie has been made
 - £30,000 on 4 April 2022 being Other Debtors as shown in the Declaration of Solvency.
 This figure consists of two Directors' Loan Account balances at the values shown in the records of the Company.

3 Joint Liquidators' Remuneration

- 3.1 The Members approved that the basis of the Joint Liquidators' remuneration be fixed by reference to the time properly spent by the Liquidators and staff in managing the Liquidation and estimated in the engagement letter at a basic cost of £2,500 plus £750 for each additional report needed after the first 12 months of the liquidation.
- 3.2 My time costs for the Period are £4,885.36. This represents 19.22 hours at an average rate of £254.18 per hour.
- 3.3 My time costs for the liquidation to date are £11,916.48. This represents 53.73 hours at an average rate of £221.78 per hour.
- Fees of £3,250 plus expenses of £426.25 has been drawn to date on account of my costs, of which £750 has been drawn during the Period.
- In addition, £3,000 has been paid in respect of pre liquidation work as per the engagement letter giving total fees paid to date of £6,250 plus expenses of £426.25.
- 3.6 Francis Clark LLP's current charge-out rates effective from the date of the liquidation are detailed below. Please note this firm records its time in minimum units of 36 seconds.
