

FINAL PROGRESS REPORT BY DAVID FORBES RUTHERFORD, LIQUIDATOR OF EPIC (WIDNES) LTD UNDER SECTION 94(2) OF THE INSOLVENCY ACT 1986 AND RULE 5.10 OF THE INSOLVENCY (ENGLAND AND WALES) RULES 2016 DATED 6 JANUARY 2020.

Introduction

The company's affairs are now fully wound up and this report provides the shareholders with a final update on the liquidation during the period 28 March 2019 to 6 January 2020.

Appointment

I was appointed liquidator at a meeting of members on 28 March 2019.

Creditors

There were no creditors in this case and HMRC have provided clearance to close the case in respect of VAT, PAYE and Corporation tax.

PRESCRIBED PART

Under the provisions of Section 176A of the Insolvency Act 1986 the Liquidator is required to create a fund from the Company's net property for the unsecured creditors (the prescribed part) where there is a qualifying floating charge post-dating 15 September 2003.

As there is no qualifying floating charge in this case, this provision does not apply

Assets

The only asset in this case was an intercompany loan due from EPIC (No.2) Limited. It was agreed with the shareholders at the outset of this case that this loan would not be ingathered and distributed to EPIC (No. 2) Ltd as EPIC (No. 2) Ltd is the sole shareholder of EPIC (Widnes) Ltd. It is noted that the beneficial owner of both companies is Ediston Property Investment Company Plc.

Statutory Work

I notified the Registrar of Companies on the progress of the winding up as required.

All meetings and appointments were advertised as required by the Insolvency Act.

Liquidator's Fees

I have received a fee totalling £1,600 plus VAT as approved by the members of the company for my services in this liquidation.

Release of Liquidator

A copy of the Final Account showing how the liquidation has been conducted and how the company's property has been disposed of has been attached to this report and provided to the members of the company in accordance with section 94(2) of the Insolvency Act 1986.

As I have not received any objections to the case being closed from the members of the company within the 8 week period following my draft account being submitted on 5 November 2019, it is my intention to submit my final account to the Registrar of Companies which will result in my release as Liquidator under Section 171(6) of the Insolvency Act 1986. My final account will be submitted to the Registrar of Companies within 14 days from 6 January 2020 being the date of my final account.
