1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

The principal accounting policies adopted are as follows: -

a) Convention

The accounts have been prepared in accordance with the historical cost convention.

b) Depreciation

Depreciation is provided on tangible fixed assets at annual rates calculated to write off the cost of each asset over its expected useful life, as follows:

Plant and machinery
12.5% per annum on the reducing balance basis
Motor vehicles
12.5% per annum on the reducing balance basis
Furniture, fittings and equipment
15% per annum on the reducing balance basis

c) Cash flow statement

The company has taken advantage of the exemption in Financial Reporting Standard No.1 from producing a cash flow statement on the grounds that it is a small company.

d) Stock

Stock is valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value.

2. TURNOVER

The turnover is the amount derived from the provision of goods and services, after deduction of VAT.
