1 Accounting Policies

Basis of measurement and preparation of accounts

The accounts have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities effective April 2008.

Turnover policy

Turnover represents the total invoice value, excluding value added tax, of sales made during the year.

Tangible assets depreciation policy

Depreciation has been provided at the following rates in order to write off the assets over their estimated useful lives.

Land and Buildings: straight line over 50 years Fixtures, fittings and equipment: 25% straight line

Computer equipment: 33.33% straight line

Intangible assets amortisation policy

Acquired goodwill is written off in equal instalments over its estimated useful economic life of 10 years.

Valuation information and policy

Going concern

As the company's total liabilities exceed its total assets, it is dependent on continued financial support from its director and its bankers in order to meet its liabilities as they fall due and to continue operating without the immediate realisation of all its assets. The director has secured the bank borrowings and intends to honour his commitment to the company to provide the necessary level of funding to ensure the company's continuance on a "going concern" basis.
