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#### REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30TH JUNE 2017

The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 30th June 2017. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015).

#### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

#### Objectives and aims

The Charity's objective is the promotion of community participation in healthy recreation particularly for the disabled community of East Sussex by the provision of facilities for playing Association Football.

#### **ACHIEVEMENT AND PERFORMANCE**

The Charity has been successful in achieving its aims to raise sufficient funds in order that the 1066 Specials sports club is able to continue to operate.

#### **FINANCIAL REVIEW**

#### **Financial position**

During the year, donations, legacies and interest received by the Charity exceeded grants to the major beneficiary by £4,253 leading to an increase in reserves by that amount.

#### Reserves policy

Reserves of £25,651 were held at 30th June 2017. This is felt to be sufficient to cover at least the next two years of expected grants to be paid to the major beneficiary as well as being available for any unexpected expenditure.

### STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT Governing document

The charity is controlled by its governing document, a deed of trust, and constitutes a limited company, limited by guarantee, as defined by the Companies Act 2006.

#### Recruitment and appointment of new trustees

The directors of the Company are also trustees of the Charity for the purposes of charity law and under the Company's articles are known as members of the Board of Trustees.

The Board of Trustees includes members with specific knowledge and skills applicable to the requirements of the Charity. Any future members will be required to have similar or complementary skills and be aware of the needs of disabled people in the context of the Charity's activities.

#### 1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

#### Basis of preparing the financial statements

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

#### **Income**

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

#### **Expenditure**

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

Grants offered subject to conditions which have not been met at the year end date are noted as a commitment but not accrued as expenditure.

#### Tayation

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

#### **Fund accounting**

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
