
In the Matter of Verizon Trading Limited

AND UPON HEARING Counsel for the Petitioner and No one appearing on behalf of the said company



**AND IT APPEARING THAT** the name of Verizon Trading Limited was struck off the Register of Companies in pursuance of the provisions of Section 652 of the Companies Act 1985

**AND** the Court being satisfied on the evidence that the EC Regulation does apply and that these proceedings are main proceedings as defined in Article 3 of the EC Regulation

**AND** there being no opposition on behalf of Her Majesty to the relief sought by the said Petition

## IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1. the name of Verizon Trading Limited be restored to the Register of Companies
- 2. Verizon Trading Limited be wound up by this Court under the provisions of the Insolvency Act 1986
- 3. the costs of the Petitioner of the Petition be paid out of the assets of the Company
