#### STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

The organisation is a charitable company limited by guarantee, incorporated on 25 September 2006 and registered as a charity on 28 February 2007. The company was established under a Memorandum of Association which established the objects and powers of the company and is governed under its Articles of Association.

The directors of the company are also charity trustees for the purposes of charity law and are known as the Trustees. Under the requirements of the Memorandum and Articles of Association the Trustees are elected or re-elected to serve until the Annual General Meeting following election or re-election.

#### **OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES**

The principal activity of the company during the year was to advance the education of the public in respect of environmental matters in respect of the reuse and recycling of unwanted reusable goods, through promotion of waste management activites, in particular through the creation and maintenance of an online gift network designed to reduce landfill and empower persons to reuse items with the object of promoting community involvement.

The main objectives and activities for the year was to maintain and increase membership to a worldwide network of members, to maintain and promote the use of an online noticeboard, and to involve local communities via administration from volunteers.

#### ACHIEVEMENTS AND PERFORMANCE

The principal funding sources and their purposes are as follows:

Grants were provided by councils in 2010 to finance ongoing website costs, purchase small items of equipment, and to provide promotional materials to aid awareness of the charity and its objectives. No grant income has been received in the current or previous financial year, but remaining reserves will be used to continue promotion, meet governance costs and provide general financial support and assistance to volunteers.

Donations of £44 (2012: Nil) were received during the year.

#### FINANCIAL REVIEW

Net outgoing resources for the year are £483.

The general fund shows a surplus at the year end of £1,288.

There are sufficient reserves available to the charity to meet governance costs for next year.

#### PLANS FOR FUTURE PERIODS

To continue to increase membership to a worldwide network of members, to maintain and promote the use of an online noticeboard, to further involve local communities via administration from volunteers, to provide consultancy services in respect of waste management, especially reduction of landfill.
