

1 Accounting policies

The financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the requirements of the Companies Act 2006 and applicable accounting standards.

2 Management and Administrative expenses

The company employs no staff. Management and administration, where required, is carried out by the parent company St John Ambulance (company number 3866129, charity number 1077265-1) which makes no charge.

3 Directors' emoluments

No director received any emoluments in respect of their services to the company for the year to 31 December 2022 (2021: £nil). The directors' services to the company do not occupy a significant amount of their time.

4 Membership

The company was incorporated on 1 November 2006 as a private company limited by guarantee and does not have a share capital.

5 Parent undertaking
