

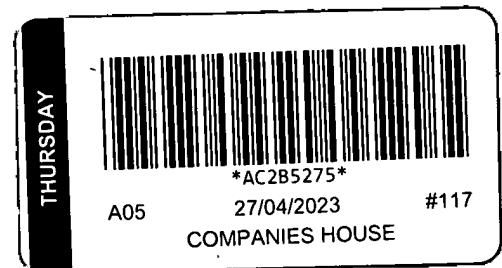


Pursuant to Chapter 2 of Part 13 of the Companies Act 2006 the directors of the Company recommend that the resolution below is passed as a Special Resolution.


SPECIAL RESOLUTION:

- (A) **THAT** under the terms of the Companies Act 2006 and on the adoption of the new Articles of Association of the Company (as per the below) the authorised share capital of the Company be dispensed with, and limits applied to the Directors' authority as set out in the new Articles attached; and
- (B) **THAT** the 50 issued shares as held by CHRISTINE NELSON be reclassified as "B" Ordinary Shares of £1 each and the 50 issued shares as held by DAMIAN NELSON GOODLAD be reclassified as "A" Ordinary Shares of £1 each. The new Articles will allow for a share capital that is comprised of "A" Ordinary Shares of £1 each, "B" Ordinary Shares of £1 each, "C" Ordinary Shares of £1 each and "D" Ordinary Shares of £1 each
- (C) **THAT** the Directors be unconditionally authorised pursuant to S.551 of the Companies Act 2006 to allot shares in the share capital of the Company which are unissued at the time of the passing of this resolution at any time or times during the period of five years from the date hereof;
- (D) **THAT** the company update its Articles of Association in line with the Companies Act 2006 and that the regulations set forth in the printed document produced to this meeting be approved and adopted as the Articles of Association of the Company, in substitution for, and to the exclusion of, all existing Memorandum and Articles thereof; and
- (E) **THAT** any rights of pre-emption, whether conferred in the Articles of Association, by statute or otherwise, be disapplied for this transaction
