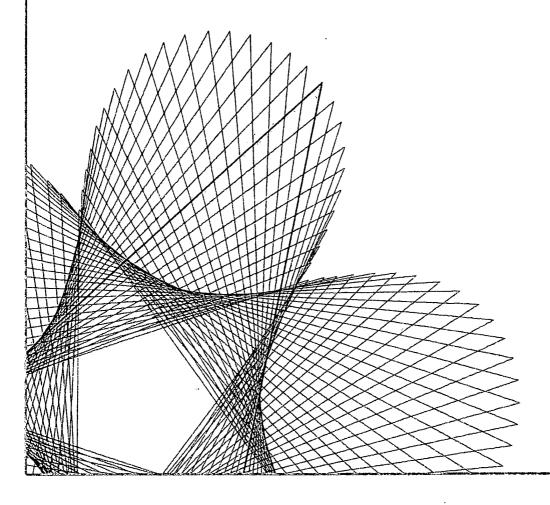

1 Introduction and Statutory Information

- Lucinda Coleman and I, of Francis Clark LLP, Centenary House, Peninsula Park, Rydon Lane, Exeter, EX2 7XE, were appointed Liquidators of Blue Water Caravans Limited ("the Company") on 26 September 2018. This report provides an update on the progress in the liquidation for year ended 25 September 2020 ("the Period").

- 1.4 The registered office of the Company was changed to Centenary House Peninsula Park, Rydon Lane, Exeter, EX2 7XE and its registered number is 06020066.

2 Progress of the Liquidation

- 2.1 At Appendix A, is my Receipts and Payments for the Period, with a comparison to the Declaration of Solvency values and cumulative figures since my appointment.
- 2.2 Members should refer to my previous report for details on previous asset realisations.
- 2.3 During the period I have received both HMRC clearances I require to take steps to close the liquidation. The only matter outstanding is a small VAT refund of £3.72 due back to the company.
- 2.4 Upon receipt of this refund I will be taking steps to close the liquidation.

3 Creditors' Claims

Secured Creditors

3.1 There are no secured creditors in the liquidation.

Preferential Creditors

3.2 There are no preferential creditors in the liquidation.

Unsecured Creditors

- 3.3 I received a claim of £4,588.35 from H M Revenue & Customs. The Director has made a Declaration of Solvency to the effect that all of the Company's debts will be paid in full, together with statutory interest, within 12 months of the commencement of the Liquidation.
- 3.4 Since the Period I have settled the HMRC liability and the necessary statutory interest. Other creditors listed on the declaration of solvency were paid prior to liquidation.

4 Distributions to Members

- 4.1 The following distribution to members has been made since the date of my appointment:
 - An interim distribution of £350,000 per share on 31 October 2018

5 Joint Liquidators' Remuneration

- 5.1 The Members approved that the basis of the Joint Liquidators' remuneration be fixed by reference to the time properly spent by the Liquidators and staff in managing the Liquidation as per our engagement letter.
- 5.2 My time costs for the Period are £3.189.20. This represents 18.02 hours at an average rate of £176.98 per hour. Attached as Appendix B1 is a Time Analysis which provides details of the activity costs incurred by staff grade during this period in respect of the costs fixed by reference to time properly spent by me in managing the Liquidation.
- 5.3 Also attached as Appendix B2 is a cumulative Time Analysis for the period from the date of my appointment to 25 September 2020 which provides details of the total time costs incurred since the date of liquidation. £2,000 plus disbursements of £373.45 has been drawn to date on account of these costs.
- 5.4 Attached as Appendix C is additional information in relation to the Liquidators' fees.

Additional Information in Relation to Joint Liquidators' Fees

1 Staff allocation and the use of subcontractors
