1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective January 2007)

Turnover

THEORY OF THE EARTH

1. The Earth is a sphere of approximately 12,756 km in diameter. It is composed of several layers, including the crust, mantle, and core.

2. The Earth's crust is the outermost layer, ranging from 5 to 70 km in thickness.

3. The mantle is the layer below the crust, extending from 70 km to 2,900 km. It is divided into the upper mantle and the lower mantle.

4. The core is the innermost layer, extending from 2,900 km to the center of the Earth.

5. The core is divided into the outer core, which is liquid, and the inner core, which is solid.

6. The Earth's magnetic field is generated by the movement of molten iron in the outer core.

7. The Earth's rotation causes the Coriolis effect, which deflects moving objects to the right in the Northern Hemisphere and to the left in the Southern Hemisphere.

8. The Earth's atmosphere is composed of gases, including nitrogen, oxygen, and carbon dioxide. It plays a crucial role in regulating the planet's temperature and protecting life from harmful solar radiation.
