

1 Accounting policies

Basis of preparation of accounts

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and are in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standards for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008)

Going concern

The company meets its day to day working capital requirements through the support of the directors which is repayable on demand. The directors consider that the company will continue to operate with this arrangement despite current liabilities exceeding current assets by £7,181. However the margin of the support over requirements is not large and, inherently there can be no certainty in relation to these matters. On this basis the directors consider it appropriate to prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis and have agreed not to withdraw their support if it causes financial hardship to the company.

Turnover

Turnover represents sales to outside customers at invoiced amounts less value added tax.

Intangible fixed assets and amortisation

Goodwill is the difference between amounts paid on the acquisition of a business and fair value of the separable net assets. It is amortised to profit and loss account over its estimated economic life.
