NOTES TO THE ABBREVIATED ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31 DECEMBER 2014

1 Accounting policies

1.1 Accounting convention

The financial statements are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

1.2 Compliance with accounting standards

The financial statements are prepared in accordance with applicable United Kingdom Accounting Standards (United Kingdom Generally Accepted Accounting Practice), which have been applied consistently (except as otherwise stated).

1.3 Turnover

The turnover shown in the profit and loss account represents rents received during the period.

In respect of long-term contracts and contracts for on-going services, turnover represents the value of work done in the year, including estimates of amounts not invoiced. Turnover in respect of long-term contracts and contracts for on-going services is recognised by reference to the stage of completion.

1.4 Leasing

Rentals applicable to operating leases where substantially all of the benefits and risks of ownership remain with the lessor are charged against profits on a straight line basis over the period of the lease.

2 Transactions with directors

The company was under the control of Mr J C Garrett throughout the current period. Mr J C Garrett is the managing director and sole shareholder.

At 31 December 2014 the company owed Mr J C Garrett £2,326 (2013 - £1,751 CR).

Lexington Leasing Ltd entered into a 125 year lease for flats owned by Lexington Continental Traders Ltd on 5 December 2007 and paid £10,440 (2013 £13,050) during the period for rent and service charges to Lexington Continental Traders Ltd, a company controlled by Mr J C Garrett. At 31 December 2014 Lexington Leasing Ltd was owed £370,976 (2013 - £476,308) by Lexington Continental Traders Ltd.
