The interest free advance to a director of £9,838 brought forward from the previous year was fully repaid in the year. Later on in the year, the company made interest free advances of £540 (2019: £10,000) and £548 (2019:nil) to two directors of the company. These advances were repayable on demand and there were no repayments in the year. The balances outstanding at the year end were £540 (2019: £9,838) and £548 (2019:nil).

The company is a private company limited by shares and incorporated in England. Its registered office is 2 Fords Grove, Winchmore Hill, London N21 3DN.
