(3) the Registrar of Companies do advertise notice of this Order in his official name in the "London Gazette"

- (4) the Claimants Janice Gwendoline Hinchliffe, Gregory Hinchliffe and Andrew Hinchliffe do jointly and severally pay to the Registrar of Companies his costs of the said Application in the agreed sum of £330-00
- (5) the hearing fixed for the 23rd July 2010 be vacated
