INTRODUCTION

I, Gordon Craig of Refresh Recovery Limited, West Lancashire Investment Centre, Maple View, White Moss Business Park, Skelmersdale, Lancashire WN8 9TG was appointed as Liquidator of Superior Awnings Limited on 11 February 2016. This is the final report on the liquidation for the period ended 12 October 2016.

ASSET REALISATIONS

Third Party Contribution to Costs

As the Company had no known assets a sum of £4,000 was received from Nicholas Sellman Holdings Limited, a Company under the control of the former director, Mr Nicholas Sellman, towards the costs of the liquidation

Net Bank Interest

Net Bank interest of 16 pence has been received within the liquidation

CREDITORS

The position in respect of the creditors can be summarised as follows

Preferential Creditors

No preferential creditor claims have been received within this liquidation

Secured Creditors

There were no charges registered against the Company at Companies House and therefore no secured creditor claims have been received in this matter

Prescribed Part

The Company did not grant any floating charges to a secured creditor. Accordingly, there is no requirement to create a fund out of the Company's net floating charge property for unsecured creditors, which only applies to charges created after 15 September 2003.

Unsecured Creditors

During the course of the Liquidation I have received a claim from HM Revenue & Customs in respect of unpaid PAYE in the sum of £3,600, VAT in the sum of £2,316, and Corporation Tax in the sum of £16,509 A claim was also received from Barclays Bank in the sum of £733

After allowing for the costs of the Liquidation there will be no funds available to permit a distribution to any class of creditor in this matter

INVESTIGATIONS

In accordance with SIP 2 I can advise that I have conducted an investigation into the affairs of the Company and I can report that I have not identified any further assets, prior transactions by the Company, or the conduct of any person involved with the Company that could give rise to a recovery for the estate

In accordance with the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986 I have submitted a report on the conduct of the Director of the Company to the Department of Business Innovation & Skills As this is a confidential report I am not able to disclose the contents

LIQUIDATOR'S FEES AND DISBURSEMENTS

Pre Appointment Fees

As creditors will recall at the first Meeting of Creditors my pre-appointment Statement of Affairs Fee was agreed at £4,000 plus VAT exclusive of disbursements. As will be noted from the receipts and payments account I have drawn £2,986 82 from the funds held within the liquidation

Liquidator's Fees

A schedule of the Liquidator's time costs, as required under the provisions set out in the Statement of Insolvency Practice 9 is attached and creditors will note that time costs incurred between 11 February 2016 to date amount to £4,115 00 which consists of 19 10 hours at an average cost per hour of £215 45
