1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

Accounting convention

Tangible fixed assets

Freehold buildings are depreciated to write down the cost less estimated residual value over the remaining useful life by equal instalments. Where buildings are maintained to such a standard that their estimated residual value is not less than their cost or valuation, no depreciation is charged as it is not material.

Service charges

The company is responsible for the management of 24 Bath Road and collects service charges from lessees in order to fund expenditure incurred in the management of the property. These service charge funds are held in trust for the lessees as required by the Landlord and Tenant Act 1987. Transactions relating to the management of the property are reported separately to the lessees and are excluded from the company's funancial statements.
