I'm delighted to report that One Cause's ninth financial period was a successful one. We delivered all our initiatives as planned.

The fundraising events we held this year went well, with the London Marathon at the heart of our achievements. Consequently, we are also seeing new people support the Cause. The continued efforts of our Trustees ensured that we continued to raise funds and maintain the initiatives we set out to do.

At Nirvana School, India, projects like Sponsor a Student continue to be popular and scale as the School grows. We still face many challenges, and one in particular is ensuring electricity is provided to the school continuously.

Our commitment to efficiency remains as strong as ever and we have worked to keep administrative costs to a bare minimum in line with our commitment to our donors. The charity's accounts, detailed later in this report, have been examined and verified by Messrs. Arithma LLP, Chartered Certified Accountants.

The Board of Trustees and I wish to thank all of our wonderful supporters whose commitment and giving nature has ensured that we have made real progress towards our mission to tackle poverty through education.

REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2017

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objects of the charity

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves policy

The charity needs to have sufficient reserves to enable it to meet its charitable obligations should there be an unexpected revenue shortfall. The existence of unrestricted reserves also offers the charity flexibility to plan and fund major projects within its two current programmes in India and Uganda. The trustees have agreed that the charity will have reserves equivalent of one year of income which will be reviewed annually to ensure sufficient funds are available to meet our obligations. The remaining funds are set aside for operational and programme investment.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is constituted as a company limited by guarantee and is therefore governed by its memorandum and articles of association.

Organisation and management

The trustees meet on a regular basis to make decisions and monitor the work of the charity.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

BASIS OF PREPARING THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

INCOME

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

EXPENDITURE

Grants offered subject to conditions which have not been met at the year end date are noted as a commitment but not accrued as expenditure.

TAXATION

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

FUND ACCOUNTING

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.
