REPORT OF THE TRUSTEES FOR THE YEAR ENDED 30 JUNE 2018

The trustees who are also directors of the charity for the purposes of the Companies Act 2006, present their report with the financial statements of the charity for the year ended 30 June 2018. The trustees have adopted the provisions of Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015).

OBJECTIVES AND ACTIVITIES

Objects of the charity

The company's principle activity and primary charitable object during the year was that of establishing or working in collaboration with educational institutions in the advancement, improvement and provision of education and training of children in developing countries in particular but not exclusively.

FINANCIAL REVIEW

Reserves policy

The charity needs to have sufficient reserves to enable it to meet its charitable obligations should there be an unexpected revenue shortfall. The existence of unrestricted reserves also offers the charity flexibility to plan and fund major projects within its two current programmes in India and Uganda. The trustees have agreed that the charity will have reserves equivalent of twelve months of income (based on the year ended 30 June 2017 income) which will be reviewed annually to ensure sufficient funds are available to meet our obligations. The remaining funds are set aside for operational and programme investment.

STRUCTURE, GOVERNANCE AND MANAGEMENT

Governing document

The charity is constituted as a company limited by guarantee and is therefore governed by its memorandum and articles of association.

Organisation and management

The trustees meet on a regular basis to make decisions and monitor the work of the charity.

Governing body

The board of trustees is authorised to appoint new trustees to fill new vacancies arising through resignation or death of an existing trustee.

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

BASIS OF PREPARING THE FINANCIAL STATEMENTS

The financial statements of the charitable company, which is a public benefit entity under FRS 102, have been prepared in accordance with the Charities SORP (FRS 102) 'Accounting and Reporting by Charities: Statement of Recommended Practice applicable to charities preparing their accounts in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland (FRS 102) (effective 1 January 2015)', Financial Reporting Standard 102 'The Financial Reporting Standard applicable in the UK and Republic of Ireland' and the Companies Act 2006. The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention.

INCOME

All income is recognised in the Statement of Financial Activities once the charity has entitlement to the funds, it is probable that the income will be received and the amount can be measured reliably.

EXPENDITURE

Liabilities are recognised as expenditure as soon as there is a legal or constructive obligation committing the charity to that expenditure, it is probable that a transfer of economic benefits will be required in settlement and the amount of the obligation can be measured reliably. Expenditure is accounted for on an accruals basis and has been classified under headings that aggregate all cost related to the category. Where costs cannot be directly attributed to particular headings they have been allocated to activities on a basis consistent with the use of resources.

TAXATION

The charity is exempt from corporation tax on its charitable activities.

FUND ACCOUNTING

Unrestricted funds can be used in accordance with the charitable objectives at the discretion of the trustees.

Restricted funds can only be used for particular restricted purposes within the objects of the charity. Restrictions arise when specified by the donor or when funds are raised for particular restricted purposes.

Further explanation of the nature and purpose of each fund is included in the notes to the financial statements.
