The Company continued to operate at the interface between community, public and private stakeholders within the built environment, working with all of these groups to achieve good outcomes in the planning and design of developments and places, for the benefit of local residents and the wider communities impacted by change.

Processes involving Design Review and Enabling have again been provided/offered during the year, although activity since the impact of the COVID pandemic has seen a reduction in the number of requests for help and changed the manner in which we operate when assigned to a task.

Design Review in Cornwall was provided until December 2022 as a partnership between ourselves and Cornwall Council and the sessions continued to include the involvement of parish council representatives as observers to the process, in order to inform and educate them about design considerations. There were 18no. reviews provided in the 22/23 financial year.

A further design review was also requested and delivered in the Torbay area, together with general advice provided about the structuring, organisation and promotion of the service.

Enabling work was most affected by the pandemic and no additional assignments were undertaken in this financial year. Since historically enabling has been the most profitable area of operation (effectively cross-subsidising Design Review) the viability of the organisation was reviewed and the directors decided it was prudent to facilitate a transition – assisting both Cornwall and Torbay to form new relationships with an alternative service provider, so as to ensure the continuation of this important work and ensuring its availability into the future.

Early in 2023, the organisation was thereby able to effectively enter a state of near dormancy, pending a decision about its future - which the directors expect to take in the next financial year.
