#### REPORT OF THE DIRECTORS FOR THE YEAR TO 31 MARCH 2016

The Directors have pleasure in submitting the Report and Accounts for the period.

#### Objects of the charity

- To advance the Christian faith, and
- To relieve sickness and financial hardship and to promote and preserve good health by the provision of funds, goods or services of any kind including through the provision of counselling and support, in Welshpool and the surrounding district and in such other parts of the United Kingdom or the world as the trustees may from time to time think fit.

#### Government

The policy and operating decisions of the charity rest with the Directors who meet regularly to monitor the activities of the Company.

#### **Review of Activities**

Apart from regular Christian meetings throughout the week, Kingswood Church is open to the public seven days a week, and we have seen a steady increase in people from the community using the church and bookshop for prayer, fellowship,

counselling/encouragement. We have available through the bookshop, resources to help and equip churches, schools and Christians to live in and serve their local communities. A local Welsh learners group regularly use the bookshop/café to practice their conversational Welsh. We are running a Trussell Trust affiliated Foodbank from the premises to serve local people in short term financial crisis. We partner with over 30 local agencies who refer clients who are facing crisis to the Foodbank.

In planning the activities the Directors have had regard to the guidance issued by the Charity Commission in December 2008 on Public benefit.

#### **Financial Review**

Income for the year was £39,564 and expenditure was £38,828, resulting in a surplus for the year of £736. Fund balances at the end of the year totalled £177,384, which included fixed assets at net book value of £146,056.

#### **Reserves Policy**

The Board of Directors have established a policy whereby free reserves held by the charity should be maintained at a level sufficient to meet its obligations in light of the current level of giving.

#### **Risk Statement**

The Directors have reviewed the risks to which a small charity operating with few employees is exposed. Appropriate procedures are in place to identify, monitor and review these risks on a regular basis.

#### **Directors' Responsibilities**

Charity law requires us as Directors to prepare financial statements for each accounting year which give a true and fair view of the state of the charity and of its income and expenditure for the year.

- 1. Select suitable accounting policies and apply them consistently
- 2. Make judgements and estimates that are reasonable and prudent
- 3. State whether the applicable accounting standards have been followed, subject to any material departures disclosed and explained in the accounts.
- 4. Prepare the financial statements on a going concern basis unless it is inappropriate to presume that the charity will continue in business.

We are responsible for keeping adequate accounting records which disclose with reasonable accuracy at any time the financial position of the company and enable us to ensure that the financial statements comply with the Companies Act 2006.

We also have a responsibility to safeguard the assets of the charity and to take reasonable steps to prevent fraud or any other irregularities

## INDEPENDENT EXAMINER'S REPORT TO THE TRUSTEES OF

#### KINGSWOOD CHURCH

I have examined the accounts for the year ended 31st March 2016 on pages 5 to 9 following which have been prepared on the basis of the accounting policies set out on page 7.

#### Respective Responsibilities of Directors/Trustees and Examiner

The directors/trustees of the company are responsible for the preparation of accounts; they consider that the audit requirements under section 144 of the Charities Act 2011 do not apply but that an independent examination is needed. I have been appointed to conduct an Independent Examination required by section 145 of the Charities Act, 2011 and to report in accordance with the regulations made under section 145 of that Act. It is my responsibility to examine the accounts, without performing an audit, and to report to the trustees.

Having satisfied myself that the company is not subject to audit under company law and is eligible for independent examination, it is my responsibility to:

- (1) examine the accounts under section 145 of the Charities Act 2011;
- (2) follow the procedures laid down in the general Directions given by the Charity Commission under section 145(5)(b) of the Charities Act 2011;
- (3) state whether particular matters have come to my attention.

#### **Basis of Examiner's Statement**

This report is in respect of an examination carried out under section 145 of the Charities Act 2011, and in accordance with the general directions given by the Charity Commissioners. An examination includes a review of the accounting records kept by the charity, and a comparison of the accounts presented with those records. It also includes a review of the accounts and making such enquiries as are necessary for the purpose of this report. The procedures undertaken do not provide all the evidence that would be required in an audit, and consequently I do not express an audit opinion on the view given by the accounts.

#### KINGSWOOD CHURCH NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR TO 31 MARCH 2016

#### 1 Accounting Policies

The accounts have been prepared under the historic cost convention, in accordance with applicable accounting standards and follow the Statement of Recommended Practice: Accounting by Charities 2005. The following are the accounting policies which have been applied in dealing with material items:-

#### a) Donated and grant income:

Donated income and grants receivable are taken into account when received by the charity. Income received in circumstances where a claim for repayment of tax has been or will be made to HM Revenue & Customs is grossed up for the tax recoverable. Any amount of tax reclaimed from HM Revenue & Customs but not yet received is shown within the charity's debtors.

#### b) Other income and expenditure:

Investment income is taken into account when receivable and expenditure, including irrecoverable VAT, when incurred by the charity, regardless of when payment is made. Grants payable are taken into account at the earlier of when they are paid or become constructive obligations. Grants for the support of [overseas] missionaries are accounted for on the basis of support that relates to the financial year.

#### c) Funds:

Unrestricted funds are donations and other income received or generated for the objects of the charity without specified purpose and are available for purposes as directed by the trustees. Restricted funds are amounts received where the donor has specified the purpose for which it should be used.

#### d) Fixed assets and depreciation:

Fixed assets acquired for use by the charity are capitalised and depreciated over their estimated useful life unless they cost less than £1,000 when they are written off on purchase.

#### Depreciation periods are as follows:

#### e) Stock

Stock is valued at the lower of cost or net realisable value.

#### f) Taxation

The company is a registered charity and is exempt from taxation under the Income & Corporation Taxes Acts.

#### g) Cashflow statement

The company has taken advantage of the exemption provided by the Financial Reporting Standard 1 and has not prepared a Cash Flow Statement for the year.
