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#### Introduction

- 1 1 This report provides an update on the progress in the liquidation of ABMDOTCOM Limited (the Company) At the first meeting of creditors held on 11 June 2010 Mr T Calverley of Walsh Taylor was appointed Liquidator of the Company
- I was appointed Liquidator of the Company by Order of the High Court on 28 March 2011 replacing Mr T Calverley. The effect of the Order is that Mr Calverley ceased to be Liquidator on that date and I became Liquidator in his place. A Copy of the Order will be made available upon receipt of a written request to this office.
- 1 3 I enclose at Appendix A an account of the Liquidator's Receipts and Payments for the year ended 10 June 2011 with a comparison to the Directors' Statement of Affairs values. In order to save costs, this information is provided in aggregate for the period of the Liquidation as a whole.
- Under the terms of the Court Order, any creditor may apply to Court for an order that Mr Calverley or myself provide separate summaries of our receipts and payments accounts. In

that event, the cost of our doing so to be dealt with as an expense of the winding up. Walsh Taylor will, in practice, be happy to provide this information to any creditor requiring it on written request to this office.

Any creditor who may wish to apply to vary or discharge the Order has liberty to do so however this must be done within 21 days of receipt of this report

#### 2 Realisation of Assets

2 1 The Company's assets were shown by the Directors in their estimated statement of affairs as at 11 June 2010 to be

- 2 3 I can advise that in accordance with Statement of Insolvency Practice 13 (SIP 13), Andrew Hinchliff, Director and shareholder of the Company at the time of the aquisition is the husband of Melody Jane Hinchliff, director of Andy's Business Machines Limited
- 2 4 I can confirm that as at the date of this report, monies have been received in full in respect of the sale of the Company's contracts/work in progress, furnishings and stock
- I confirm that to date we have not received the cash at bank and at present I am in protracted correspondence with the Yorkshire Bank in respect of the same. Any further realisations in respect of this asset will be detailed in my next report.
- 2 6 Total asset realisations achieved to date therefore are £16,170 37

#### 3 Investigations

- In accordance with the Company Directors Disqualification Act 1986 the liquidator has submitted a report on the conduct of the Directors of the Company to the DTI. As this is a confidential report, I am not able to disclose the contents
- The Liquidator also has a duty to investigate the extent of the Company's assets including potential claims against third parties including the Director(s), and to report her findings, subject to considerations of privilege and confidentiality and whether those investigations and/or any potential litigation might be compromised
- The preliminary assessment of the conduct of the Company's affairs prior to winding up did not reveal any matters that it was in the interest of creditors for the Liquidator to pursue Accordingly 1 am not conducting or proposing to conduct any further, more detailed investigations however I will of course continue to monitor the Company's situation
- If you are aware of any matters in connection with the Directors' conduct, which you may think relevant to my investigations, please advise me in writing. This request forms part of the Liquidator's usual investigation procedures and does not imply any criticism of the Directors.

#### 4 Creditors

#### **Secured Creditors**

4.1 There were no secured creditors in this liquidation

#### Preferential Creditors

The National Insurance Fund claims the sum of £1,028 preferentially in respect of payments made to former employees of the Company for claims for wages and holiday pay

#### **Unsecured Creditors**

The Liquidator has received claims totalling £68,613 43 from eight creditors. I have yet to receive claims from 15 creditors whose debts total £129,144.80 as per the Directors' Statement of Affairs.

#### Notice of no dividend

4 4 Assets realised have been and will be utilised fully in contributing towards defraying the administrative costs of the liquidation

Accordingly, formal Notice is hereby given in accordance with Rule 11.7 that no funds are expected to become available to enable any form of distribution to be made to any form of creditor.

#### 5 Liquidator's Remuneration, Disbursements and Expenses

#### Basis of the Liquidator's remuneration

- At the initial meeting of creditors held pursuant to Section 98 of the Act on 11 June 2010 it was resolved that the Liquidator would be remunerated by reference to the time properly spent in dealing with this matter at Walsh Taylor's standard charging rates, and that his disbursements would be drawn in accordance with Walsh Taylor's standard tariff (see Appendix B)
- There have been no increases to Walsh Taylor's charge out rates or disbursement tariff since then
- The aforementioned bases of remuneration and disbursements also apply to myself as successor Liquidator

#### Remuneration charged and disbursements incurred

- In aggregate, the Liquidator's post liquidation time costs as at 10 June 2011 total £10,934 50 in respect of 79 36 hours at an average hourly rate of £137 37. A detailed breakdown is attached at Appendix C.
- 5.5 Disbursements incurred are summarised at Appendix D

#### Remuneration and disbursements drawn

- As at the date of this report no monies have been drawn by way of Liquidator's remuneration
- 5.7 Details of disbursements drawn are set out in Appendix D

#### Liquidation expenses charged and drawn

- Details of the costs incurred and paid by the Liquidator in relation to liquidation expenses are also attached at Appendix D
- I comment specifically that at the first meeting of creditors held on 8 June 2010 it was resolved that the fees and disbursements of Walsh Taylor for assisting the Directors in

convening the statutory meetings to place the Company into liquidation and for assistance in preparing the Statement of Affairs would be a set fee of £10,000 plus VAT, to be paid out of the assets of the Company, together with disbursements incurred

5 10 Accordingly, the sum of £9,648 09 plus VAT has been drawn in this respect
