Notes to the Abbreviated Accounts for the Period Ended 31st December 2010

1. Accounting policies

Basis of measurement and preparation of accounts

The financial statements have been prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting for Smaller Entities (Effective April 2008).

Turnover policy

The turnover shown in the profit and loss account represents revenue earned during the period, exclusive of VAT.

Tangible fixed assets depreciation policy

Depreciation is provided, after taking account of any grants receivables, at the following annual rates, in order to write off each asset over its estimated useful life: Plant and Machinery - 15% on cost, Fixtures and Fittings - 10% on cost, Motor Vehicles - 25% on cost.

Intangible fixed assets amortisation policy

Intangible fixed assets (including purchased goodwill and patents) are amortized at rates calculated to write off the assets on a straight basis over their estimated useful economic lives, not to exceed twenty years. Impairment of intangible assets is only reviewed where circumstances indicate that the carrying value of an asset may not be fully recoverable.

Valuation information and policy

Stocks and work-in-progress are valued at the lower of cost and net realisable value, after making due allowance for obsolete and slow moving items. Cost includes all direct expenditure and an appropriate proportion of fixed and variable overheads.

Other accounting policies

Assets obtained under hire purchase contracts or finance leases are capitalized in the balance sheet. Those held under hire purchase contracts are depreciated over their estimated useful lives. Those held under financial leases are depreciated over their estimated useful lives or the lease term, whichever is the shorter. The interest element of these obligations is charged to the profit and loss account over the relevant period. The capital element of the future payments is treated as a liability. Rentals paid under operating leases are charged to the profit and loss account on a straight line basis over the period of the lease. Research and Development Expenditure is written off in the year in which it is incurred.
