During the Liquidation I have realised the following company assets:

### Cash at Bank

The Declaration of Solvency estimated the sum of £25,684 was held in the Company's bank account. Following my appointment, a total sum of £25,141.03 was received.

### **Bank Interest**

During the liquidation the sum of £40.87 has been received in interest.

### **Total Assets**

In total assets totalling £25,181.90 have been realised.

### Case progress

The declaration requires that the Liquidation be completed within a 12 month period, however we have encountered delays in receiving confirmation from H M Revenue & Customs that we can close the liquidation. I have since received clearance from H M Revenue & Customs Corporation Tax department and am awaiting final clearance from the department dealing with other taxes. The liquidators are required to undertake the following work in order to ensure that the liquidation is brought to a conclusion.

- Receive confirmation from HM Revenue & Customs
- · Calculate and issue final distribution
- Issue final report

### **Payments to Creditors**

As per the Declaration of Solvency no creditors claims were outstanding. I have since my appointment received a claim from H M Revenue & Customs for £1.80 which has been paid from the liquidation account.
