

ORDER

UPON the application of Stephen Mark Powell ("the **Application**")

AND UPON reading the second witness statements of Stephen Mark Powell and Brett Lee Barton

IT IS ORDERED THAT:

- 1 The First Respondent, Brett Lee Barton, is removed from his office as Administrator in respect of the company in Administration which is set out in Schedule A hereto.



2. The Applicant, Stephen Mark Powell, is appointed as Administrator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the company which is set out in Schedule A hereto. In the event that the said company goes into voluntary liquidation the Court hereby appoints Stephen Mark Powell to be a liquidator with effect from the date of liquidation. For the avoidance of doubt, nothing in the Order shall prevent the creditors of the company from seeking to exercise their power to nominate another person as proposed liquidator pursuant to paragraph 83(7)(a) of Schedule B1 of the Insolvency Act 1986, or section 139(3) of the Insolvency Act 1986.
3. The First Respondent, Brett Lee Barton, is removed from his office as Liquidator in respect of the companies in Creditors' Voluntary Liquidation which are set out in Schedule B hereto.
4. The Applicant, Stephen Mark Powell, is appointed as Liquidator in substitution of the First Respondent in respect of the companies which are set out in Schedule B hereto.
5. The Applicant shall procure that, at the first convenient opportunity to do so, and in any event within 3 months of the date of the Order, a block advertisement in respect of each of the insolvency appointments listed in Schedules A and B shall be placed in the London Gazette containing notification of the following matters.
 - 5.1 the removal of the First Respondent and the substitution of the First Respondent by the Applicant;
 - 5.2 that creditors and debtors have liberty to apply, within 35 days after the notice has been advertised, to vary or discharge the Order;
 - 5.3 that creditors and debtors have liberty to apply within 35 days after the notice has been advertised, to object to the First Respondent's release;
 - 5.4 that in the case of the Administration listed in Schedule A, the First Respondent will be released from all liability both in respect of any of his acts and omissions in relation to his conduct as office-holder of the estate with effect from 35 days from the date when the notice has been advertised, SAVE that in the event that an application in relation to the insolvency appointment has been made by a creditor or debtor, within the relevant time period, objecting to the said release, the First Respondent will be released in relation to the insolvency appointment 28 days after the said application has been disposed of (whether by agreement or by order of the Court) or further order of the Court in the meantime; and
 - 5.5 that in the case of the Liquidations listed in Schedule B, the First Respondent will be entitled to apply to the Secretary of State for his release upon the expiry of 42 days from the date the notice has been advertised, SAVE that in the event that an

application in relation to one of the insolvency appointments has been made by a creditor or a debtor, within the relevant time period, objecting to the said release, the First Respondent will not seek to apply for his release in relation to that insolvency appointment until after the said application has been disposed of (whether by agreement or by order of the Court).

6. The advertisement in the London Gazette may be made together with the advertisement of the block transfer of insolvency appointments dealt with under the Order of Insolvency and Companies Court Judge Mullen in this matter and dated 11 December 2019.
7. In relation to the insolvency proceedings listed in the Schedules hereto, and insofar as the Insolvency Act 1986 or the Insolvency (England and Wales) Rules 2016 contain any requirement for advertisement of the removal of the First Respondent or his substitution by the Applicant, compliance with paragraph 5 above shall be deemed as being sufficient compliance with any such advertisement provisions and for the avoidance of doubt, any further compliance with such notice provisions shall be waived. Insofar as the First Respondent is required by law to give any notice of his removal from office, the Applicant is entitled to sign and send any such notice on his behalf.
8. The period to be covered by progress reports to members and/or creditors and the dates by which those reports need to be sent to members and/or creditors and filed with the Registrar of Companies (if applicable) shall not be altered by virtue of the making of the Order or the replacement of the First Respondent by the Applicant pursuant to this Order; and for the avoidance of doubt, any such requirement necessitating an alteration in the reporting dates by reason of the date of commencement, termination or replacement of an office holder's appointment, are hereby waived.
9. In the Administration listed in Schedule A hereto, the First Respondent be released from all liability both in respect of any of his acts and omissions in relation to his conduct as office-holder of the estate with effect from 35 days from the date when the relevant notice referred to in paragraph 5 above has been placed in the London Gazette, SAVE that in the event that an application in relation to the insolvency appointment has been made by a creditor or debtor, within the relevant time period, objecting to the said release, the First Respondent will be released in relation to the insolvency appointment 28 days after the said application has been disposed of (whether by agreement or by order of the Court) or further order of the Court in the meantime.

10. In each Liquidation listed in Schedules B, the First Respondent shall be at liberty to apply to the Secretary of State for his release upon the expiry of 42 days from the date when the relevant notice referred to in paragraph 6 above has been placed in the *London Gazette*, *SAVE that in the event that an application in relation to one of the insolvency appointments has been made by a creditor, a member in the case of Members' Voluntary Liquidations, or a debtor, within the relevant time period, objecting to the said release, the First Respondent will not seek to apply for his release in relation to that insolvency appointment until after the said application has been disposed of (whether by agreement or by order of the Court).*
11. The costs of and occasioned by the Application shall be paid by Begbies Traynor (Central) LLP.
12. *There be liberty to apply.*
