REVIEW OF ACITIVITIES:- 2021 - 2022:

The year 2021 / 2022 has been yet another exciting year for BWA in the current climate of restricted funding faced by all voluntary organisations. Despite that, BWA has been able to accomplish many significant achievements, for which the Directors of BWA can be proud of and as such like to extend their deepest gratitude to all those who contributed in making those achievements possible. The achievements are summaries as below:

1. Education Home Work Classes:

The homework tuition and guidance for secondary school pupil remains the main focus of the services provided by BWA. In addition to that BWA appointed an Advice Worker to assist with community development work that is being undertaken.

2. Support 360

The project has been running for over 4 year and offers advice on issues including housing, benefits and immigration to name but a few. More recently, the organisation has employed a female worker as a Project Officer to increase access and help deliver the project to the wider community.

3. Awards for All & Project Engage

BWA continues to work with the local community and members of the public. Funded by Community Champions (Administered by Burnley Borough Council) by making 3 videos to inform & educate people & dispel myth of Covid 19.

4. Energy 360

The project is designed to assist homeowners and make it easier for them to:

- Read and understand their utility bills.
- Switch suppliers more easily.
- Apply for the government energy saving schemes e.g. Green Homes Grant.

The entire purpose of the project is to help residents to take ownership and to reduce fuel poverty.
