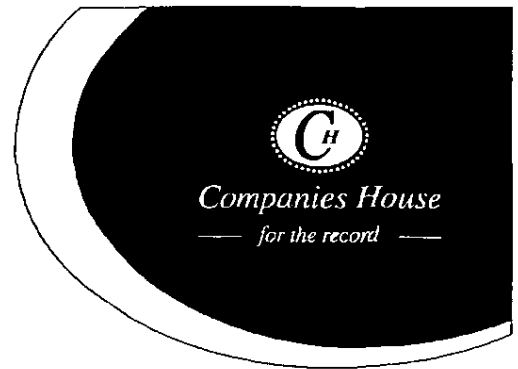

### PROPOSED COMPANY REMOVAL

Since we sent our letter of 23/10/2010 to your Registered Office, the company record has not been brought up-to-date. In our earlier letter we said that we were considering removing your company from the register as it appeared to be no longer trading or operating.

If you are content for your company to be struck off the register and dissolved, there is no need to respond to this letter. In this case, a notice of our intention to remove the company will be published in the London Gazette. A further notice will be published approximately 3 months later at which time the company will be struck-off and dissolved.

If, however, you wish to keep the company you must, **within a month of this letter**, either bring the company record up-to-date by delivering the overdue document(s), or write to us to confirm that the company is required and to tell us when we can expect to receive the document(s).

Please note that the company will incur an automatic financial penalty for any accounts delivered late. Where there is a failure to comply with filing requirements of the 2006 Companies Act in consecutive years, the penalty will be doubled for the current year's accounts.
