Spacehoppas supports minority groups such as Sandwell Asian Family Support service by providing free visits and passes designed to build race relations in the community

Children who might have been excluded from coming to the centre, mainly due to tack of finances have been able to mix with other children and develop socializing skills. The range of play equipment provided challenges the children and helps build their confidence Parents also find the experience of mixing with other parents rewarding, building positive relationships, sharing ideas and experiences
