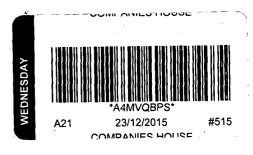

<u>Independent Examiner's Report to the Trustees of Weston & District Community Transport Limited.</u>

I report on the accounts of the Charitable Company (Charity Number 1132653) for the year ended 31st March 2015, which are set out on pages 5 to 10.

Respective responsibilities of Trustees and Examiner

The Charity's Trustees are responsible for the preparation of the accounts. The Charity's Trustees consider that an audit is not required for this year under Section 144 of the Charities Act 2011 (the Charities Act) and that an independent examination is needed.

It is my responsibility to:

These accounts have been prepared in accordance with the provisions applicable to companies subject to the small companies' regime in Part 15 of the Companies Act 2006 and with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

NOTES TO THE ACCOUNTS FOR THE YEAR ENDED 31ST MARCH 2015

1. ACCOUNTING POLICIES

a) Basis of Accounting

The accounts are prepared under the historical cost convention and in accordance with the Financial Reporting Standard for Smaller Entities (effective April 2008).

b) Depreciation

Depreciation is calculated to write down the cost of fixed assets to their estimated residual value over their expected useful lives. The annual rates and method of calculation are as follows:

Motor Vehicles	25% Straight Line
Office Equipment	25% Straight Line
Computer Equipment	33% Straight Line

As the Motor Vehicles taken over by the Charity are more than four years old, these have been fully depreciated in this first operating period.

c) <u>Deferred Taxation</u>

Provision is made for deferred tax in respect of all timing differences that have originated but not reversed by the balance sheet date at the rate that would apply when the timing differences are expected to reverse. There was no liability at the end of this year or last.

2. SHARE CAPITAL

The Company is limited by guarantee and therefore no shares have been issued. The maximum liability of any member of the company is £1.

3. CORPORATION TAX

As the company is a charity it is not subject to corporation tax on its profits, and has no investment income.
